

Assistant Regional Director Report

Fall 2011

The 2010-2011 ski season was pretty good as far as skiing goes, and the EMARI region stayed committed to the training and service to its members. I payed a visit to Blue Hills and Yawgoo where I patrolled in an effort to take note of patrollers concerns. As the chairman of the election committee I organized and compiled the votes for regional director, a task that we will again take on this year as Mr. Pringles election was only to fill the remainder of John Shipman's term.

I organized the EMARI weekend at Black Mountain in NH, in March, with a total of 25 EMARI ski patrollers and 35 family members as participants.
