



Division guidelines for Applying to become a Ski and Toboggan Trainer Evaluator

These rules are not intended to discourage or create a hardship for those aspiring to this level. They are intended to insure that patrollers are ready for this step and have prepared sufficiently to be successful. There may be occasions where the TE candidate can shortcut some of these guidelines because of prior experience or longevity.

- 1) Must be a Senior or higher level Patroller
- 2) Must be an “active” toboggan Instructor for a period of at least 1 year.
- 3) Must have the approval of the Regional Ski and Toboggan Administrator
- 4) Must shadow the regional ski and toboggan staff for at least 1 year (minimum of 5 events).
- 5) Must attend a division sponsored Patroller’s school as a TE candidate. (Attend the Trainer Evaluator prep course sessions)
- 6) Must be “signed off” by a Ski and toboggan Instructor Trainer
- 7) *Fill out and submit an “Eastern Division Ski and Toboggan Trainer Evaluator Clinic Application” to the appropriate Regional Ski and toboggan Administrator at least 30 days prior to the event
- 8) The Eastern Division ski and toboggan supervisor may waive any or all of these requirements
